

Supply list for Acrylics Class

For each class please bring:

Canvas or Canvas Boards: You will need one or two per class of any size you prefer.

1 sturdy water bowl (Cool Whip size is good)

1 Roll Paper Towels

Paint and brushes: I am offering 2 options for paint and brushes:

Option 1: Instructor will provide a set of Professional paint, palette knife and brushes:
Cost: \$85

Option 2: Bring your own paint, brushes and a palette knife:

Supplies below are recommended. They can be purchased at Michaels, DickBlick.com or JerrysArtarama.com.

Paint: Heavy Body Acrylics are HIGHLY recommended. Golden Heavy Body or Liquitex Heavy Body have the most pigment for the money. (*NOTE: Liquitex BASICS is NOT the same paint*). You will need 6-8 colors.

- **Recommended basic set of colors:**

Titanium White

Paynes Gray (or Ivory Black),

Cadmium Yellow Light (or Hansa Yellow) – *or Cadmium Free*

Cadmium Orange – *or Cadmium Free*

Alizarin Crimson

Dioxine Purple

Cerulean Blue Hue

Brushes: You'll need at least two brushes: one large and one small. Recommended sizes 12 and 8 or 6 and 10 of a synthetic bristle or hog bristle with a **long handle**. Brushes should be a bit "stiff", not soft.

Palette Knife: The most useful shape is called Trowel. It has a triangle shape and a bend down from the handle.

Palettes and other supplies will be provided by instructor.
